Martin Halle MD PhD

Associate Professor, Department of Plastic- and Craniofacial Surgery, Karolinska University Hospital, Stockholm Sweden

Martin Halle received his medical degree (M.D.) from Karolinska Institutet (KI), Stockholm, parallel to translational Ph.D.-studies. He completed his training in Plastic Surgery at the Department of Reconstructive Plastic Surgery, Karolinska University Hospital 2008. Part of his early training in microsurgery was conducted at UCLA, USA. After completed training in Plastic Surgery and Ph.D. degree at KI, he had a part time postdoc appointment at Karolinska University Hospital/KI, parallel to his clinical work and is now Associate Professor in Plastic Surgery.

Martin Halle has been holding the position as Director of Microsurgery at Karolinska University Hospital, where he has mainly focused on cancer reconstruction of the breast, head and neck. His current research is focused on breast surgery, with a particular interest in capsular contracture and radiation-induced tissue damage. Martin Halle has his aesthetic plastic surgery practice at Art Clinic and is in charge of the Swedish Breast Implant Registry (BRIMP). Martin Halle is national representative for UEMS section of Plastic Surgery and European Board of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery (EBOPRAS), where he also is an examiner for fellows of European Board of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery (FEBOPRAS). He is also an active member of EURAPS, where he has been a part of the scientific committee for several years.
